The amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, provided that the following change is made.

- Response to PR Notice 2001-1 (First Aid Statement)

Revise the Hazards to Human and Domestic Animal statement to read:

“Danger. Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Do not get in eyes, skin or on clothing. Avoid breathing vapor. Wash hand thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Handles must wear long sleeved shirt and long pants, shoes plus socks, goggles or face shield, chemical resistant gloves such as or made out of any waterproof material.

A stamped copy of the accepted labeling is enclosed for your records. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before releasing for shipment the product bearing the revised labeling.


