

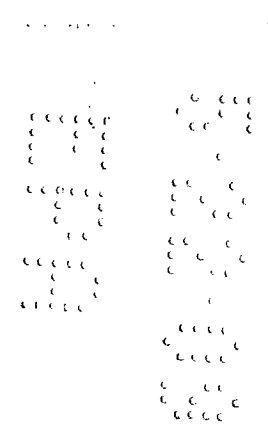

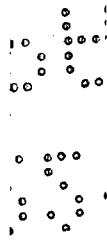
This product should be used full strength at concentrations of 30 ppm of B244 on a continuous basis, or in slug applications to 5,000 ppm of B244 or higher concentrations as needed (1/4 pint per 1,000 gallons equals approximately 30 ppm). A typical slug application is one quart per 1,000 gallons.
