

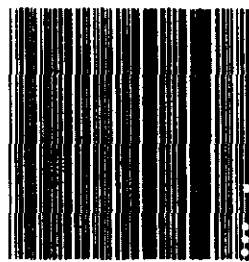

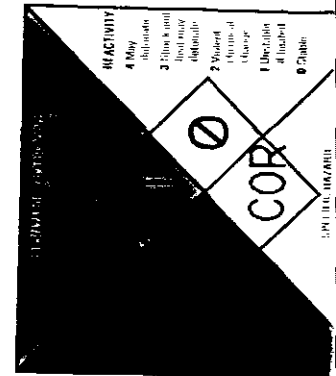

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

### HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**DANGER:** Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Vapor harmful. Avoid breathing spray mist or vapors. Do not get on skin. Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritations. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Avoid contamination of food.

## ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish and wildlife. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. ## FIRST AID

### IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:

1. Take off contaminated clothing.
2. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.
3. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

### IF IN EYES:

1. Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.
2. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.
3. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

### IF INHALED:

1. Move person to fresh air.
2. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible.
3. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

### IF SWALLOWED:

1. Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.
2. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.
3. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor.
4. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For use with closed delivery systems only.

X-CIDE 105 Industrial Bactericide will control bacteria found in waters associated with petroleum production. It will control bacteria in water which collects in tank bottoms, in water for flooding operations, in water disposal systems, gas transmission and completion of fluids.

X-CIDE 105 Industrial Bactericide may be applied in systems used to treat injection water immediately ahead of water deoiling equipment, in the water holding tank, or at the suction side of the injection pump.

X-CIDE 105 Industrial Bactericide should be used full strength in concentrations of 15 ppm of X-CIDE 105 Industrial Bactericide on a continuous basis or in applications up to 2,500 ppm of X-CIDE 105 Industrial Bactericide as often as needed (1/8 pint per 1,000 gallons equals approximately 15 ppm). A typical application is 1/2 pint per 1,000 gallons.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess biocide or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law.
