Revise the label as follows:

1. Revise the Precautionary Statements to read:

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER. Causes severe eye damage or skin burns. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin or inhaled. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wear goggles, safety glasses or face shield when handling. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

2. Revise the "Container Disposal" section per PR Notice 83-3 to read:

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:
