
General Comments

DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with labeling.

FRACTURING FLUIDS: X-CIDE is used for the prevention of contamination and degradation of the oil and gas industry. X-CIDE pre-mixing of the fracturing fluid aqueous solution may be added to the procedure.

FREQUENCY AND DOSE: X-CIDE should be added at a rate of 2.0 to 36 ppm) depending on the quality of the water.

Treatments should be made using the following procedure:

STORAGE

DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER

STORAGE: Store in a dark, cool, dry place in original containers, away from energy sources, heat, and moisture.
