DIRECTIONS - FOR SPOT APPLICATION ONLY
HOUSEHOLD PESTS—ANTS, BOX ELDER BUGS (Outside Buildings) - 2 Tablespoonfuls (1 oz.) in 1 gallon water. Apply along runways, in cracks in cement walks and patios, around garbage containers, under porches, around outside house foundations. Also spray box elder trees and ornamentals where bugs congregate. Spot treat nests in lawns or other infested areas.

ANTS, ROACHES, SPIDERS (Inside Buildings) - 6 Tablespoonfuls (3 ozs.) per gallon water. Spray thoroughly only trails around door sills, window frames, openings around water pipes, heat ducts, electrical outlets and baseboards, where these pests may enter. Do not contaminate food, utensils, dishes or drinking water. Do not use in edible products areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed. Use a coarse, wet spray. Repeat as necessary. May cause staining of finished surfaces.

LAWN PESTS—INSECTS: JUNE BEETLE GRUBS, WHITE GRUBS, JAPANESE BEETLE GRUBS, SOD WEBWORMS, LAWN MOTH LARVAE, ANTS, MOLE CRICKETS, CUTWORMS, GRASSHOPPERS, CHIGGERS - Spray thoroughly at 2 Tablespoonfuls (1 oz.) in 1 gallon water per 150 sq. ft. area (1 pint in 15 gallons water per 2400 sq. ft.).

EARWIGS: 2 Teaspoonfuls in 1 gallon water. Apply in damp, shady areas, around and under boards and similar places. Repeat as necessary.

TERMITES—Subterranean: Dig a trench along the outside of the foundation walls. In brick or hollow block or concrete foundations, dig a trench to, but not below the footing.

Mix 4 ozs. Chlordane 50% per gallon of water. Then as the trench is refilled, treat the soil at the rate of 4 gallons per 10 linear feet for each foot of trench depth. A trench 3 feet deep would require 12 gallons per 10 linear feet. The objective is to establish a treated soil barrier which will prevent termite entry. Other critical areas may also require treatment. It is suggested that you consult the State Extension Service for advice.
