

# Golden Glow

Whitens, Removes  
Stains, Bleaches

## CAUTION—Read Carefully

**ANTIDOTE:** If swallowed, give milk or cooking oil. Call physician. If spilled on the skin, bathe with cold water or cornstarch solution. If splashed in eyes, flush with water. See doctor if irritation persists.

**DO NOT USE** on silk, wool, unfast colors, leather, any sponge except vinyl. Check drip-dry fabrics and wash-and-wear before using bleach.

**DO NOT USE** on silver, aluminum, steel, or chipped enamelware.

**DO NOT USE** with ammonia, toilet bowl cleaners, or other chemicals. Septic tanks are not affected by normal home and farm use.

**HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED.** Skin and eye contact may cause severe irritation. Do not get in eyes or on skin.

## ECONOMICAL DISINFECTANT FOR DAIRY, FARM, MANY USES

**PENS, CAGES, POULTRY COOPS, INCUBATORS, ETC.**—Clean away all surface dirt. Wash thoroughly clean. Rinse or spray with solution of 1 cup per gallon water; keep wet 5 to 10 minutes.

**SWIMMING, WADING POOLS**—In order to establish a chlorine residual of 1.0 ppm in the pool water, add 1 ounce of Golden Glow Bleach for each 100 gallons of water. For 3200 gallons water add 1 quart Golden Glow Bleach). Mix amount of Golden Glow Bleach required with 2 or 3 gallons of water and spread evenly over the pool. Test the pool water periodically with a suitable chlorine test kit and add Golden Glow Bleach as required to maintain 0.6 to 1.0 ppm available chlorine at all times.

**FLOODED BASEMENTS**—Scrub all surfaces thoroughly clean. Then rinse or spray with solution of 1 cup to a gallon of water. Keep wet 5 to 10 minutes. Follow Health Departments instructions.

**DRAIN PIPES**—To help keep down odors, flush drain pipes with boiling water. Then pour in 1 cup.

**GARBAGE CANS**—Wash thoroughly clean with warm suds. Rinse, then fill with clean water and add one-half cup for each gallon. Let stand 5 to 10 minutes.

**RESTAURANTS, TAVERNS, FOUNTAINS, DAIRIES, ETC.**—1. Scrape and prewash utensils and glasses whenever possible. 2. Wash with a good detergent or compatible cleaner. 3. Rinse with clean water. 4. Sanitize in a solution of 1 ounce to 2 gallons of water (200 ppm). Immerse all utensils for at least two minutes or for contact time specified by governing sanitary code. 5. Place sanitized utensils on rack or drainboard to air dry.

## WHITENS AND BLEACHES Nylon, Dacron, Cotton, Linen

Do not use on silk, sponge, wool, leather.

**ALL LAUNDERING** — Use ¼ cup Golden Glow Bleach to each 4 gallons tepid suds. **IN AUTOMATIC WASHERS**—dilute required amount in quart water and add to washer when filled with water. **TO DISINFECT**, add 1 cup bleach to first rinse, immerse clothes ½ hour. **BABY CLOTHES**—Always bleach to make them sanitary, sweet-smelling. Rinse well.

**TO REMOVE STAINS** — wash out starch or dressing. Mix 2 tbsp. in quart cold water. Soak 15 minutes. Rinse. Repeat if necessary. Use also to whiten age-yellowed nylon. For scorch, mildew, dry in sun.

**PERMANENT PRESS** — Most permanent press fabrics are bleachable. Check the manufacturer's instructions for washing.

**SICK ROOM** — Wash and clean all articles and surfaces. Disinfect glasses, rubber sheets, bed pans, urinals, Use 1 cup Golden Glow Bleach to gallon water. Immerse article 5 minutes. Rinse well.

**DENTURES** — add 8 drops to ½ cup water, immerse for 15 minutes.

**CLEANING** — use 1 cup to gallon water to clean refrigerator, drainboard, bathtub, washbowl, floors.

**LINOLEUM, PORCELAIN, TILE** — to clean, whiten, brighten—add 1 cup to gal. warm scrubbing suds. Same for white woodwork.

**TOILET BOWLS** — pour in cup; swish on surfaces. Let stand hour. See caution regarding bowl cleaners.

**DEODORIZE** — use for odors of onions, pets, garbage, musty odors.
