

# Swim Magic Dry Super Chlorinator

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** Use a clean, dry plastic cup to scatter SWIM MAGIC DRY SUPER CHLORINATOR in deep end of pool. Dry Super Chlorinator will aid in the control of most algae and bacteria. This material contains no stabilizer and should be used for superchlorination only. All superchlorination should be done when there are no

swimmers present and swimming should not be resumed until the chlorine residual has dropped below 2.0 ppm. But, never permit the residual to go below 0.6 ppm at any time. With water temperature above 75°F., Super Chlorinate once every 2 weeks with 4 ounces SWIM MAGIC DRY SUPER CHLORINATOR per 5,000 gallons pool water.

**ATTENTION:** Plastic and Vinyl Lined Pools, always pre-dissolve DRY SUPER CHLORINATOR at the rate of 8 ounces per gallon in a plastic pail before adding to pool.

**DANGER:** Strong Oxidant. Keep away from combustible organic materials to avoid fire. Prevent any burning material such as a lighted cigarette from falling into product. Drench fires with water. When measuring, use only clean, dry plastic cup. Do not get on skin or in eyes. May produce severe chemical burns. Flush spilled product with water. Keep in cool, dry place in original container.

**ANTIDOTE: External** – flood eyes or skin with large amounts of water for 15 minutes. If irritation persists, get medical attention. For eyes – call physician.

**Internal**—drink large quantities of water or milk. Follow with milk of magnesia, vegetable oil, or beaten eggs. Call physician immediately. USDA Reg. No. 10718-2
