DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Shake vigorously for best results. Point valve away from tube and slightly downward. For best results, use when air is calm and breeze is slight.


For Flying Insects: Spray with breeze and allow fog to drift over area. When treating grass or bushes stand 4 to 6 feet away and allow spray to drift onto areas to be protected. Repeat as necessary.

For Crawling Insects: Ants, Crickets, Centipedes — Spray infested areas of campground, yard, patio, or picnic area hitting as many insects as possible. Spray legs of tables and chairs to repel crawling insects. Spray ant hills and trails thoroughly for best control.

NET WT. 20 OZ. Avoid contact and prolonged or repeated skin contact. Do not spray toward face or smoke at mouth or eyes.

Do not spray near food or pets. Keep 4 to 6 feet away from experimental plants when spraying. Do not spray near fish ponds.

Do not spray near flammable materials or incinerate. Do not spray near stoves, radiators or any other place where temperature may exceed 120° F. Excessive temperature may cause container to burst.

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS: DEET. A strong smelling oil used as a repellent for ticks, chiggers, gnats, flies, mosquitoes, and other biting and stinging insects. Related compounds have been used as repellents for many years. DEET is effective against most insects, but it is not a general insect repellent. DEET is not effective against fleas, lice, mites, or scabies. DEET is not effective against ants, wasps, bees, hornets, or other flying insects.
