DIRECTIONS

For one step cleaning and sanitizing, dilute 1 ounce BYSAN in a gallon of water. If used for sanitation of food contact items, surfaces must be scrubbed thoroughly with detergent and rinsed with potable water prior to use. For one step cleaning, deodorizing and disinfecting, dilute 1/2 ounces BYSAN in a gallon of water. At this level, BYSAN is fungicidal against pathogenic fungi, Trichophyton Interdigitale (athlete's foot fungi). For hospitals where BYSAN is to be pseudomonicidal, dilute 2 ounces BYSAN in a gallon of water. This has been substantiated by AOAC 11th edition use dilution confirmation tests. **DO NOT REUSE EMPTY CONTAINER. RINCE THOROUGHLY WITH WATER BEFORE DISCARDING OR RETURNING TO DRUM RECONDITIONER.**
