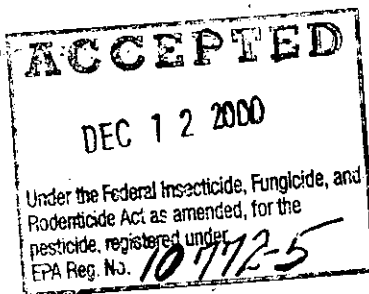

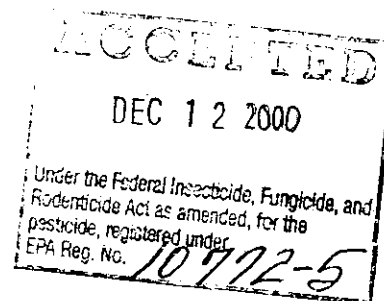

<b>If swallowed</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.</b></li> <li>• <b>Have person drink several glasses of water if able to swallow.</b></li> <li>• <b>Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor.</b></li> <li>• <b>Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.</b></li> </ul>
<b>If on skin or clothing</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Take off contaminated clothing</b></li> <li>• <b>Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-30 minutes.</b></li> <li>• <b>Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.</b></li> </ul>
<b>If in eyes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.</b></li> <li>• <b>Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.</b></li> <li>• <b>Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.</b></li> </ul>
