- 2. Insure that your correct registration number appears on the label as your July 14, 2003, letter and amended application form for EPA Reg. No. 10772-12 incorrectly identified the registration number as "EPA Reg. 10772-17.

Do not spray food or feed crops. For both indoor and outdoor situations, use training whenever possible, including positive (praise) and negative (sharply spoken word backed up with disciplinary action) reinforcement. This product repels dogs and cats for up to 24 hours when applied daily. Keeps pets away from furniture, carpet, trees, shrubs, garbage cans/bags, and other "forbidden" areas.

Pretreatment Directions: Stray animals are frequently attracted to areas where pets have soiled with faces or urine. To discourage repeat visits, remove any droppings and clean with water.

Application Directions: Do not apply directly to foliage of shrubs or to ornamental, soft-bodied plants. Do not apply to food or feed crops. Lightly spray surrounding soil or apply to a piece of cloth and affix near area to be protected every day.
