In reference to the CSF dated 04-10-92 for your basic formulation:

- (1) Since your product is a 100% repack of a registered product, delete 99% under Column 13b for Copper Sulfate Pentahydrate and replace it with 100%. Delete all reference to "Inert Ingredients (water soluble impurities)" under Column 10 and the corresponding 1% under Column 13b. The nominal concentration of $CuSO_4 \cdot 5H_2O$ in your product is 100% x 99% or 99% which agrees with the label claim.
- (2) Specify the density in terms of lb/gal, grams/cc or lb/cu.ft. in Block 7, if known. Otherwise specify "N/A".

Please submit a corrected CSF for our files.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the following comments:

- (1) The active ingredient should be listed in the ingredient statement as "Copper Sulfate Pentahydrate" without any parentheses.

In stubborn cases, one or two additional cans may be required.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Do not re-use empty container. Rinse thoroughly, then securely wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
