DIRECTIONS

1. Keep E-Z TRIM tape dry until ready for use.
2. Clip the vegetation on the strip to be edged.
3. Loosen the top soil with a hand tool.
4. Lay the E-Z TRIM tape along the line where control is desired. The line may be straight or curved. Fasten E-Z TRIM to the ground with nails or picks.
5. Sprinkle E-Z TRIM tape with a fine spray of water. The tape will dissolve, releasing the chemicals into the soil.
6. Spray intermittently during the first several hours to be sure the chemicals are fixed into the soil. After the chemicals are fixed, water as normal.

REQUIRED CAUTIONS

- 1 HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED
- 2 AVOID INHALATION OF VAPORS OR FUMES
- 3 AVOID STORAGE NEAR FEED AND FOOD PRODUCTS.
- 4 When watering in E-Z TRIM, do not use a watering can or a strong hose force
- 5 DO NOT apply more water than the soil can readily absorb
- 6 DO NOT puddle or wash with initial watering
- 7 DO NOT USE E-Z TRIM on extreme slopes, where water runs off as fast as it is applied. This will cause a ragged edge on the strip.
- 8 Around shallow-rooted plants use E-Z TRIM outside the periphery of the crop line.
