

**AIR-O-CIDE  
DIRECTIONS**

**U.S. Public Health Service (71.513E)**

1. The insecticide shall be dispensed in the amount of 1/2 ounce per 100 cu. ft. of enclosed space in the aircraft, and shall be released or sprayed through all accessible compartments.
2. Disinsectization may be accomplished either while the aircraft is in flight or while on the ground prior to take-off, but in no case shall disinsectization be accomplished later than 30 minutes prior to the first landing at a United States port.
3. The ventilation system shall be stopped and the doors kept to the exterior, except while the insecticide is being released or sprayed, and for a period of not less than 3 minutes thereafter. If disinsectization is accomplished on the ground prior to take-off, the ventilation system may be opened at the end of the period provided that the system is equipped with filters or other means for preventing the entrance of insects into the aircraft, but door, windows, or other such openings to the exterior shall be kept closed until after the take-off, except in the case of emergency, to permit persons applying the insecticide to disembark.
