DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

For Face Flies: Remove mucous secretions and saliva deposits from face of animal. Hold dispenser 18 to 24 inches from animal. Spray face and other body regions where flies gather for 3-4 seconds per animal. Repeat daily, or as needed.

For Horse Flies, Horn Flies, Stable Flies, Deer Flies, Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Gnats: Hold container 18 to 24 inches from animal. Apply lightly to coat with a sweeping motion. Apply to back, belly, ear, or leg regions where the specific attacking insect feeds. Do not spray entire animal. Spray young animals sparingly. Do not apply to back of horses prior to sanding. Repeat daily, or as needed, for protection.
