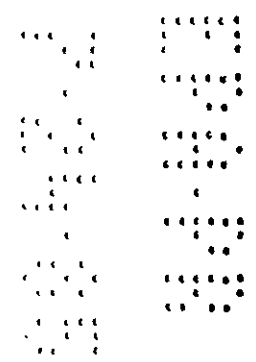

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Hold container 19 to 24 inches from animal. Apply lightly to coat with a sweeping motion. Apply to back, abdomen, ear, or leg regions where the specific attacking insect feeds. Do not spray entire animal. Spray young pets sparingly. To help insure maximum protection against mosquitoes, dogs should be sprayed every 3 to 4 hours when outside.
