For eyes, call a physician." to read "If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Drink promptly large quantities of water. Immediately contact physician and obtain treatment".
- 2. Revise your Environmental Hazard statement to read "This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authoricy. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA".
- 3. Delete the statement "Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed".

It is intended for use as a disinfectant for telephones, bed springs, door knobs, linen carts, hampers, wheel chairs, tables, cabinets, light switches, garbage pails and other clean inanimate, non-porous, hard surfaces. In addition, deodorizes those areas which generally are hard to keep fresh smelling, such as garbage storage areas, cmpty garbage bins and cans, basements, restrooms, shower stalls, and other areas which are prone to odors caused by microorganisms. This aerosol surface disinfectant also be used as a room air deodorizer and refresher.
