The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act removing the active ingredient, NCK R-11, and increasing the amount of another active ingredient is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. Submit the flashpoint of this product with the propellant or change the physical hazards statement to:

Extremely Flammable. Contents under pressure.  
Keep away from fire, sparks, and heated  
surfaces. Do not puncture or incinerate  
container. Exposure to temperatures above  
130 °F may cause bursting.

2. Change the precautionary labeling to read:

May cause eye irritation. Avoid breathing  
spray mist. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid  
contact with eyes or lips. Do not allow  
children to rub eyes if hands have been  
treated.

3. Delete the term "General Classification."

4. Add the statement "Do not puncture or incinerate" to the Storage and Disposal statement.
5. Delete the statement "Keep Out Of Reach Of Young Children And Infants" on the back panel.
6. The amendment is being accepted as a change in the basic formulation. It cannot be accepted as an alternate formula. Submit a revised Confidential Statement of Formula with the proper block marked.
7. Submit a 1-year storage stability study. The formulated product must be analysed for its active ingredients at time zero and for a year in storage. The storage must be under warehouse conditions of temperature and humidity using containers similar to those which will be used in the trade. This data must be submitted within 15 months of the date of this letter.

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

Storage and Disposal

Storage: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Do not re-use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

To repel the insects listed on the Front Panel, first remove protective cap. Hold can at least 12 inches away, point valve in desired direction and press button to spray. Apply liberally to all exposed skin areas. To apply to face, spray on hands and rub on. Repeat as needed. For ticks and chiggers, also apply liberally to shoe tops, socks and around openings in clothing.

Avoid contact with plastics, such as eyeglass frames, and such fabrics as acetate rayon.
