SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE, HOLD CAN IN UPRIGHT POSITION. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

This product is formulated to kill common pests: Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Gnats, Cockroaches, Ants, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Rice Weevils, Crickets, Carpet Beetles, Confused Flour Beetles, Firebrats, Fleas, Brown Dog Ticks, Sowbugs, Centipedes, and Spiders.
