The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable subject to the comments listed below.

1. There are no current food tolerances for use of Phenothrin in food/feed handling areas. This label is silent with regards to where this product may be used. Therefore, within the Directions for Use, directly below the statement "It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling." Insert the following new statement: "**Do not use** this product in areas other than residential, or non-food commercial areas."

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. HOLD CAN IN UPRIGHT POSITION. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

This product is formulated to kill common pests: Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Gnats, Cockroaches, Ants, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Rice Weevils, Crickets, Carpet Beetles, Confused Flour Beetles, Firebrats, Fleas, Brown Dog Ticks, Sowbugs, Centipedes, and Spiders.

TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, SMALL FLYING MOTHS AND GNATS: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

TO KILL COCKROACHES, ANTS AND CRICKETS: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL CARPET BEETLES: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL EXPOSED FORMS OF CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLES, SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES, AND RICE WEEVILS: Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL SOWBUGS, CENTIPEDES, FIREBRATS AND SPIDERS: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators.

TO KILL FLEAS AND BROWN DOG TICKS: Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried. Also treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area.
