

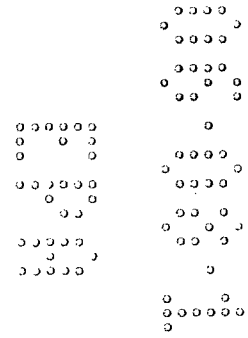

**Shake Well Before Use.** Hold can in upright position. Apply in short bursts.

This product is formulated to kill common pests: Ants, Brown Dog Ticks, Carpet Beetles, Centipedes, Cockroaches, Confused Flour Beetles, Crickets, Firebrats, Fleas, Flies, Gnats, Mosquitoes, Rice Weevils, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Small Flying Moths, Sowbugs, and Spiders.

**To Kill Flies, Gnats, Mosquitoes and Small Flying Moths:** Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

**To Kill Ants, Cockroaches and Crickets:** Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

**To Kill Carpet Beetles:** Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

**To Kill Exposed Forms of Confused Flour Beetles, Rice Weevils and Saw-Toothed Grain Beetles:** Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the names

insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

**To Kill Centipedes, Firebrats, Sowbugs and Spiders:** Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators.

**To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas:** Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried. Also treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area.
