insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Centipedes, Firebrats, Sowbugs and Spiders: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried. Also treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area.
