4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.



Depress button, continuing to spray until the nest or the area sprayed is completely saturated. Application at night after the insects have returned to their nest is preferable. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.  
DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
