The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling change listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

Under Precautionary Statements revise "food" to "food/feed", i.e., "Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed"

The Agency has reevaluated the data and labeling requirements for aerosol products and has published in the Federal Register a notice soliciting comments from industry and public entitled "Pesticide Aerosol Flammability; Solicitation of Comments" (56 FR 6856, February 20, 1991). Until a final decision has been made, the Agency will accept the flammability statement which appears on the previously submitted labeling for the subject product. A stamped copy has been enclosed for your records.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION

May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Avoid inhalation of vapors and contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash contaminated skin promptly with soap and warm water. For eyes, flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs.

Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas such as dining rooms but excluding areas where food may be prepared or held. In the home, cover all food handling surfaces and cover or remove all food and cooking utensils, or wash thoroughly after treatment. Cover or remove exposed food.

Nonfood areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Physical or Chemical Hazards

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. KEEP CONTAINER UPRIGHT.

This product will kill Cockroaches, Houseflies, Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Rice Weevils, Small Flying Moths, Fleas, Ticks, Pill Bugs, Crickets.

Cover exposed food, dishes, and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 5,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

BEST AVAILABLE COPY

TO OPERATE VALVE: To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press the valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for four hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

To Kill Ticks and Fleas: Destroy pet's old bedding and replace. Use product as above. Treat dogs and cats with a registered tick and flea control product prior to re-entry.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
