The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(a), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data or other material required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) or FIFRA section 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a) On page three please have a line between ¶... Pill Bugs, and Crickets.¶ and ¶Cover exposed food...¶. They should be separate paragraphs.
 - b) On page three ¶Do not use in food/feed ... Cover or remove exposed food/feed.¶ should also be a separate paragraph.
 - c) On page three ¶Non-food areas ... (after canning and bottling.)¶ should also be a separate paragraph.
 - d) Remove pets, birds, cover fish aquariums before spraying.¶ should also be a separate paragraph.

3. Submit two (2) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. One 5-ounce aerosol can treats up to 5,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area (a room 25' x 37' with an 8 foot ceiling). DO NOT use more than one fogger per room. DO NOT use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters or tables. Do not use in a room 5 ft. x 5 ft. or smaller; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms. Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.) Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. KEEP CONTAINER UPRIGHT

This product will kill Cockroaches, Houseflies, Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Rice Weevils, Small Flying Moths, Fleas, Ticks, Pill Bugs, and Crickets.

Cover exposed food, dishes, and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit to each 5,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

TO OPERATE VALVE: To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press the valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for four hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.


TO KILL TICKS AND FLEAS: Destroy pet's old bedding and replace. Use product as above. Treat dogs with a registered tick and flea control product prior to re-entry.
