The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Permethrin Interim Decision and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 12 months from the date of this letter. After 12 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently

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approved labeling. “To distribute or sell” is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

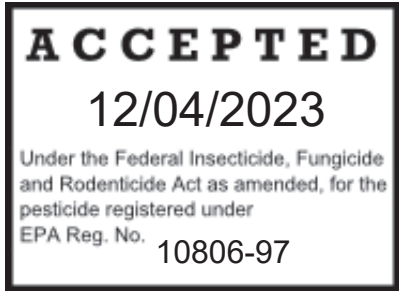

Precautions and Restrictions

For Only Indoor Use

Shake well before use. Keep Container Upright.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. Do not apply when food is present. Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs. Do not treat establishments where livestock feed is present. Do not apply directly to food. Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants, or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas include areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms, but exclude areas where foods may be prepared or held. In the home, cover all food processing surfaces and utensils during treatment or thoroughly wash before use following treatment. Cover or remove exposed food. To Use This Product Correctly

DO NOT use more than one fogger per room. **DO NOT** use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters or tables. Use of a fogger in an enclosed space may cause the product to explode, resulting in injury to people or damage to property. Do not use in a room 5 ft. x 5 ft. or smaller; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms. **Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.).** Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.

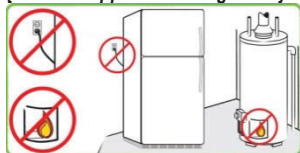

How to Use

Step 1: Before You Fog

Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application. Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment and food preparation surfaces, or wash them before use. Remove pets and birds; cover and turn off fish aquariums before activating fogger.

Step 2: Preparation:

Cover wood floors and wood furniture in the immediate area around the fogger with newspapers or a drop cloth. Open cabinets, cupboards, drawers, closets and doors in areas to be treated to allow maximum kill in all areas where insects can hide and breed. Close outside doors and windows. Shut off fans, air conditioners and ventilation equipment to maximize killing power of fog. Place a chair, small table or stand in the center of the room to be treated and cover with newspaper. One 3 ounce canister of fogger [Each 3 oz. can] will treat a room 20' x 20' with an 8-foot ceiling [(3,000 cubic feet)]. Use only 1 canister for each 3,000 cubic feet of space. Fill out and place hang-tag on the door to the treated area to alert family members and others with access to the treated area not to enter for 2 hours after treatment.

[One 4 ounce canister of fogger [Each 4 oz. can] will treat a room 23' x 22' with an 8-foot ceiling [(4,000 cubic feet)]. Use only 1 canister for each 4,000 cubic feet of space.]

[One 5 ounce canister of fogger [Each 5 oz. can] will treat a room 25' x 25' with an 8-foot ceiling [(5,000 cubic feet)]. Use only 1 canister for each 5,000 cubic feet of space.]

[One 6 ounce canister of fogger [Each 6 oz. can] will treat a room 30' x 25' with an 8-foot ceiling [(6,000 cubic feet)]. Use only 1 canister for each 6,000 cubic feet of space.]

[One 7 ounce canister of fogger [Each 7 oz. can] will treat a room 35' x 25' with an 8-foot ceiling [(7,000 cubic feet)]. Use only 1 canister for each 7,000 cubic feet of space.]

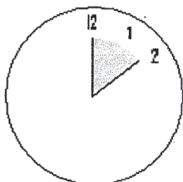
[One 7.5 ounce canister of fogger [Each 7.5 oz. can] will treat a room 37' 6" x 25' with an 8 foot ceiling [(7,500 cubic feet)]. Use only 1 canister for each 7,500 cubic feet of space.]

[One 8 ounce canister of fogger [Each 8 oz. can] will treat a room 40' x 20' with an 8 foot ceiling [(8,000 cubic feet)]. Use only 1 canister for each 8,000 cubic feet of space.]

Step 3: To Start Fogging:

Shake Well Just Before Using. To Operate Valve: Point fogger away from face and eyes when releasing (container sprays straight up). To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, firmly press valve button down, hooking the catch [until it snaps into place]. Then place the fogger on the stand or table in the center of the room.

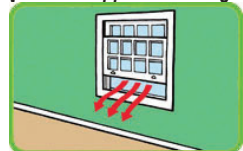
Do not re-enter for 2 hours.



Step 4: Airing Out:

Do not remain in the treated area; **immediately vacate the treated house, individual apartment unit or other structure and remain outside.** Do not allow adults, children or pets to re-enter the treated area/structure for a minimum of 2 hours to ensure the vapors, mists and aerosols have dispersed. Thoroughly ventilate the treated area before reoccupying. If an odor is still detectable after 2 hours, additional ventilation is required.

Air Out the Room Before Entering.

To Kill Ticks and Fleas: Destroy pet's old bedding and replace with clean, fresh bedding after treatment is completed. Use product as above. Treat pets with a flea and tick control product registered for use on pets prior to allowing pets to reenter treated premises. Also treat your yard with a flea and tick control product registered for yard application. **This product does not control bed bugs.**

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) area away from food, pet food and sources of heat or ignition. **Pesticide Disposal:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. **Pesticide/Container Handling:** Do Not Incinerate or Puncture! **If empty:** Offer for recycling if available; otherwise discard in trash.
