- e. Since your data matrix did not provide a dielectrical breakdown voltage, you must add the following statement to the Physical or Chemical Hazards section:

Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

#### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Harmful if swallowed. Contains petroleum distillate. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration pneumonia hazard. Do not breathe vapors or spray mist. Causes slight eye irritation. Do not get in eyes. Avoid contact with skin and clothing. Wash contaminated skin promptly with soap and warm water. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** This product contains a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine, by injection, is antidotal and should be administered only if signs of cholinesterase inhibition have appeared.

Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

#### PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**General:** Spray surface to wetting. Do not use as a space spray. Use only for crack and crevice and spot treatment.

**To Kill Ants, Confused Flour Beetles, Crickets, Earwigs, Rice Weevils, Roaches, Sawtoothed Grain Beetles, Silverfish, Sowbugs and Spiders:** Spray into cracks, crevices, around baseboards, and other places where these insects hide. Apply behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and in and around waste containers. Contact directly as many insects as possible. For ants, spray trails and places where ants enter premises. Repeat as necessary for control.

**To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas:** Remove and destroy old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after spray has dried. Do not spray animals. Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product prior to reentering treated areas.

**To Kill Carpet Beetles and Dermestids:** Spray along baseboards, edges of carpeting, under carpets and rugs, under furniture, in closets, on shelving, and in other places of harborage. Repeat as necessary.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

**DISPOSAL:** Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
