HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

C A U T I O N

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. In case of contact immediately flush skin and eyes with plenty of water. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine, by injection, is antidote of choice.

Do not apply while food processing is underway. Cover or remove all food processing surfaces. Thoroughly wash all food processing surfaces before reuse. After spraying in bakeries, meat packing plants, food processing plants; all benches, shelving, equipment, where exposed food will be handled must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse to remove all traces of contamination. In the home all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food.

Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surface until spray has dried.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

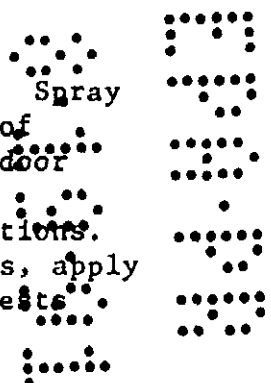
DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

GENERAL: Use this residual spray as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control ants, cockroaches, fleas, silverfish, ticks, and other insects listed below. Apply this product as a coarse spray to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT:

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Sowbugs, and Spiders: Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets; and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Fleas and Ticks: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters; nearby cracks and crevices; along and behind baseboards; window and door frames; and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Pet's old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. DO NOT SPRAY PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT. Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product prior to reentering treated premises.

FOR CRACK AND CREVICE:

To Kill Ants, Carpet Beetles, Cockroaches, Crickets, Dermestids, Earwigs, Fleas, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, and Ticks: Apply diluted spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of delivering a pin stream should be used in points between elements of construction; between equipment and floors; openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls; equipment legs and bases where the above listed insects hide.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

APPLICATIONS OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS OTHER THAN AS A CRACK AND CREVICE AND SPOT TREATMENT ARE NOT PERMITTED.

Flies and Mosquitoes: Use only outdoors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under eaves) of porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.

Do not apply this water-based product in conduits, motor housings, junction and switch boxes, or other electrical equipment because of possible shock hazard.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL	
STORAGE:	Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.
DISPOSAL:	Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
