HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Solvent may present aspiration hazard. This product contains a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine, by injection, is antidotal and should be administered only if signs of cholinesterase inhibition have appeared. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be used in conjunction with atropine.

Do not apply as a space spray. Do not apply directly to food. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food or food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is under way. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food.

Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of equipment wastewater.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

GENERAL: Use as a spot crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, waterbugs, silverfish, ticks, fleas and other insects listed below. Apply this product to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet.

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SPOT TREATMENT: To Kill Ants, Crickets, Earwigs, Roaches, Silverfish, Sowbugs and Spiders: Spray into cracks, crevices, around baseboards, and other places where these insects hide. Apply behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and in and around waste containers. Contact directly as many insects as possible. For ants, spray trails and places where ants enter premises. Repeat as necessary for control.

TO KILL BROWN DOG TICKS AND FLEAS: Remove and destroy old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after spray has dried. Do not spray animals.

TO KILL DERMESTIDS AND CARPET BEETLES: Spray along baseboards, edges of carpeting, under carpets and rugs, under furniture, in closets, on shelving, and in other places of harbourage. Repeat as necessary.

FOR CRACK AND CREVICE - APPLY AS FOLLOWS: To Kill Ants, Brown Dog Ticks, Carpet Beetles, Crickets, Dermestids, Earwigs, Fleas, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders: Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of delivering a pin stream should be used in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where the above listed insects hide.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid Contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

APPLICATIONS OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS OTHER THAN AS A CRACK AND CREVICE AND SPOT TREATMENT ARE NOT PERMITTED.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry, place. Keep container closed.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
