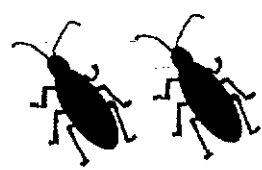

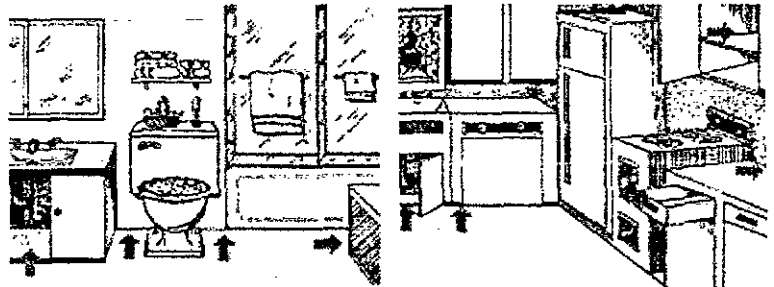

### BACK PANEL

**DIRECTIONS:** It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. Break individual Bait Discs apart from plastic frame.
2. Do not remove Baits from box until ready to use. Use all 12 Bait Discs at one time for thorough roach control.
3. Remove all food sources and foods (crumbs, sugar, oil, grease) from areas where Baits are to be placed.
4. Place Baits primarily in kitchen areas and bathrooms. Also place near sources of food and water and where roaches have been seen. Other areas might include the pantry, utility room, near exposed plumbing fixtures, windows, and doors.
5. Place Baits under sinks, in corners, under stoves or refrigerators, in cabinets. Roaches will feed on the bait and generally return to their hiding place to die.
6. Replace Bait Discs every 3 months to keep roaches from returning.

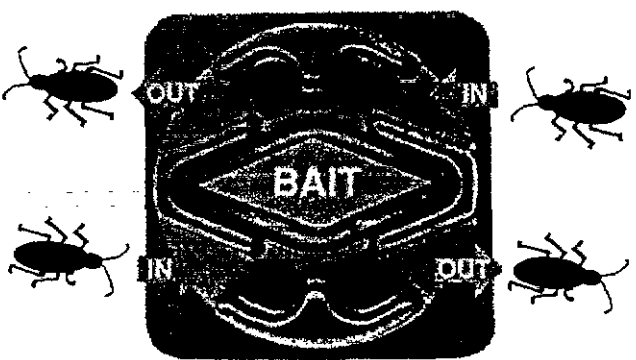


Locate Bait Discs in areas indicated by arrows.
