The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act to bring the label into compliance with current requirements is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

1. Add the statement "Do not puncture or incinerate" to the container disposal section.
2. The word Resmethrin should precede the chemical name in the ingredient statement.
3. The Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) on record for this product does not meet current requirements. Submit the required EPA Form 8570-4 (Rev. 2-85). A blank copy is enclosed for your use. All applicable items must be completed correctly. Note that you are required to include in the form certified limits for each component introduced into your product (formulation). Also you must specify in the CSF certified limits for each active ingredient so declared on the proposed label for your product. The certified limits for the active ingredients must be expressed as pure active ingredients. Note also that the certified lower limits for the active ingredients expressed therein cannot be lower than your label declarations for the active ingredients. In other words, the current regulations require that the label declarations for the active ingredients be the same as the certified lower limits. Refer to the enclosed guide for completing the CSF correctly.

WARNING

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Call a physician immediately. In hospitals, patients should be removed from room prior to treatment. Room should be ventilated for 2 hours after spraying. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

Do not apply directly to food in commercial food handling facilities. Cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is under way. After space spraying in food processing plants, thoroughly wash all equipment, benches, shelves, etc., where exposed food will be handled, with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse. All food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Remove birds and pets. Cover fish aquariums before spraying.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Remove protective cap, holding dispenser upright, point valve in desired direction and press dispenser button to spray.

Mosquitoes, Flies, Gnats. Close doors and windows. Direct the spray to all parts of the room. Fill the room with mist, then leave the treated area. Keep room closed for at least 15-30 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

Wasp. Application should be made in the late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

For Crawling Insects: Roaches, earwigs, grain mites, sowbugs, spiders and centipedes. Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, baseboards, and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible.

Ants. Spray trails, nests, and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place away from heat and open flame.
DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and place in trash collection.
