



FOGGER

Kills exposed flies, mosquitoes, gnats, flying moths, wasps, spiders, fleas, ticks, ants, earwigs & centipedes.

For Bakeries, Food Plants; Restaurants, Schools, Hotels, Motels, Office Buildings & Hospitals.

DIRECTIONS: Use one can for each 10,000 cu. ft. or unobstructed area. Shut off fans, air conditioners, all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows and keep closed for 2 hours before airing out. Point the valve opening away from your face while locking the valve into position, then place it on a stand or table covered with newspapers in center of unobstructed area. Leave the building at once and ventilate at least 30 minutes before returning.

The can may be used manually or the valve can be locked in open position. To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge press arrow on valve button all the way forward, hooking the catch over the lip of metal rim.

To kill flying insects use as a fogger. To kill crawling insects, spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, baseboards and storage areas.

If this can has been sprayed manually use a new can for fogging or use the partial can in smaller than 10,000 cu. ft. areas.

Use in food processing plants only when plant is not in operation. Food should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered or thoroughly cleaned before using. In hospitals, patients should be removed from room prior to treatment. Room should be ventilated for 2 hours after spraying before returning patients to the room. Avoid contamination of food & feed stuff. Remove pets, birds & fish before using.
