The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Refer to the enclosed document "Label Requirements for Antimicrobial Pesticides Used on Hard Surfaces Against HIV-1 (AIDS Virus)" for EPA's current labeling policy for efficacy claims. Your labeling must be revised in accordance with requirements outlined in this policy notice.
 - b. Delete "Tetrasodium ethylenediamine tetraacetate", Sodium metasilicate" and Essential oils" from the active ingredient. These are considered inert ingredients. Adjust your inert ingredient percentages accordingly.
 - c. "Change the heading "Directions" to "Directions for Use."

- d. On the right panel under the directions for use" immediately above "Special instructions For Cleaning . . ." add the following statement to read:

"KILLS HIV ON PRE-CLEANED ENVIRONMENTAL SURFACES/OBJECTS PREVIOUSLY SOILED WITH BLOOD/BODY FLUIDS in health care settings or other settings in which there is an expected likelihood of soiling of inanimate surfaces/objects with blood or body fluids, and in which the surfaces/objects likely to be soiled with blood or body fluids can be associated with the potential for transmission of human immunodeficiency virus Type 1 (HIV-1) (associated with AIDS).

- d. Delete the word "milk" from the "Statement of Practical Treatment."
- e. Under "Note to Physician", delete the sentence "Measures against circulatory shock"


2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
