SUBJECT: Resubmission in Response to Agency Letter of 07/16/97
Misty Powder Puff Residual Insecticide
EPA Reg. No. 10807-33
Your Submission Dated October 6, 1999

Dear Ms. Watson:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, are acceptable provided you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling:

1. Under "Container Disposal" revise the end of the statement to read, "... or by other procedures approved by State and local authorities."
2. The retreatment statements should include a maximum frequency of application, such as: "... but not more than ___ times per ___."
3. Also under INDOORS, add the following before the retreatment statement: "Cover all food handling surfaces and cover or remove all food and cooking utensils or wash thoroughly after treatment. Exposed food should be covered or removed."
4. At the end of the directions for treating pantry pests, insert the following: "Wash any exposed food handling surfaces and utensils before use."
5. Under TO CONTROL FLEAS, insert the following: "Do not spray animals or humans, or apply to animal feed or watering equipment."
6. Delete the statement beginning, "In the home all food processing surfaces...", since the product is intended for use in commercial industrial sites.

7. Explain what "427-16" refers to on the front panel.

EPA will issue a PR Notice revising first aid statements in the near future. The following are the revised statements that will be required for products placed in category III and above. You may wish to incorporate these statements on your labeling at this time :

SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eyes. Call a poison control center for treatment advice. IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice."


Also, add the following statement near the first aid statements: "Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment."

EPA recommends that these statements be boxed and bulleted to present the information in a clear, easy-to-read fashion.

Further, we advise that you change the 6th sentence under PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS to read: "Do not apply where spray may settle onto food or utensils."

Submit two copies of your final printed labeling before you release the above referenced product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records. If you have any questions regarding this letter, please contact Linda Werrell of my team at (703)308-8033.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:
DANGER: Corrosive. Causes eye damage. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Do not apply directly to food. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is underway. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.
STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention. **IF SWALLOWED:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Gastric lavage may be indicated if material was taken internally. **DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING:** vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. **IF INHALED:** Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. **IF ON SKIN:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.
PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS: EXTREMELY FLAMMABLE! Do not use or store near fire, sparks or heated surfaces. Turn off pilot lights in gas appliances and unplug or turn off electrical equipment in the use area. After airing out phase is completed, relight pilot lights and reconnect electrical current. Do not smoke in the use area. Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Incineration of container may cause explosion.
DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: **STORAGE:** Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame. **DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection. Do not incinerate or puncture.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE AND AT INTERVALS DURING USE.

TO OPERATE: Remove cap. Hold can upright, aim valve from about 13 inches from area to be sprayed and depress button. Avoid heavy deposits on finished surfaces.

FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS: Places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared or served.

FOOD AREAS - APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY: includes areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing) preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups) and serving areas (when food is exposed and facility is in operation).

TO CONTROL ANTS, COCKROACHES, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS AND CENTIPEDES: Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using an insertion tube in points between different elements of construction, motor housings, junction of switchboxes and bases in conduits, air conditioners, breaker boxes, relays, meters, light housing, water pump housing and swimming pool motors. Prior to application, de-energize electrical equipment. After application, allow time for oil to evaporate before starting motors or placing switches in "ON" position. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the insecticide onto exposed surfaces or introducing it into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.
APPLICATION OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS OTHER THAN AS A CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT IS NOT PERMITTED.

SERVING AREAS: Facilities where foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where food may be prepared or held, apply as a spot treatment to selective surfaces and into cracks and crevices. Avoid treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food. (Do not apply when facility is in operation or foods are exposed).

NON-FOOD AREAS: Including garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), offices, locker rooms, and storage (after canning or bottling). Apply as a spot treatment to baseboard areas, around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables, pallets and similar areas where insects hide or through which they may enter. Repeat treatment as required.

TO CONTROL FLEAS: In animal quarters, treat bedding, floor and floor coverings and any areas where fleas may hide. If left undisturbed, a deposit of this product will continue to kill fleas for several weeks. Repeat application when effectiveness diminishes.
