Dear Ms. Watson:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. Delete the following statements from the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section, since these or similar statements are already included under the Directions for Use:

"Do not apply where spray may settle onto food or utensils. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application.

2. Move the following restriction from the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section to the Directions for Use in "Food Handling Establishments":

"Do not apply while food processing is underway."

3. Move the following restriction from the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section to the Directions for Use (near the beginning, since it applies to all application sites on the label):

"Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying."


4. Since this product contains petroleum distillate, please revise the oral First Aid statements as recommended in PR Notice 2001-1 for such products:

<b>If swallowed:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Immediately call a poison control center or doctor.</li> <li>• Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor.</li> <li>• Do not give any liquid to the person.</li> <li>• Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.</li> </ul>
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You must also add the following statement to the Note to Physician, based on the product's petroleum distillate content: "Contains petroleum distillate - vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia."

5. Revise the statement near the bottom of the front panel to read "See side panel for additional precautions", since the Statement of Practical Treatment ("First Aid") is now on the front panel.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:**  
 Irritant. Causes eye damage. Hazard if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing vapors or mists. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Wash goggles, face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Do not apply where spray may reach into food or animals. **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** **STORAGE:** Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do Not Puncture or Incinerate IF EMPTY: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. IF PARTLY FILLED: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.

**SHAKE WELL BEFORE AND AT INTERVALS DURING USE.**

**TO OPERATE:** Remove cap. Hold can upright, aim valve from about 13 inches from area to be sprayed and depress button. Avoid heavy deposits on finished surfaces.

**FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS:** Places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared or served. Cover all food handling surfaces and cover or remove all food and cooking utensils or wash thoroughly after treatment. Exposed food should be covered or removed. **FOOD AREAS - APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY:** Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing) preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (milk, dairies, edible oils, syrups) and serving areas (when food is exposed and facility is in operation).

**TO CONTROL ANTS, COCKROACHES, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS AND CENTIPEDES:** Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using an insertion tube in points between different elements of construction, motor housings, junction or switchboxes and bases in conduits, air conditioners, breaker boxes, relays, meters, light housing, water pump housing and swimming pool motors. Prior to application, de-energize electrical equipment. After application, allow time for oil to evaporate before starting motors or placing switches in "ON" position. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the insecticide onto exposed surfaces or introducing it into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces. Wash any exposed food handling surfaces and utensils before use. **APPLICATION OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS OTHER THAN AS A CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT IS NOT PERMITTED.**

**SERVING AREAS:** Facilities where foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where food may be prepared or held, apply as a spot treatment to selective surfaces and into cracks and crevices. Avoid treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food. (Do not apply when facility is in operation or foods are exposed).

**NON-FOOD AREAS:** Including garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), offices, locker rooms, and storage (after canning or bottling). Apply as a spot treatment to baseboard areas, around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables, pallets and similar areas where insects hide or through which they may enter. Repeat treatment as required but not more than one (1) time per week.

**TO CONTROL FLEAS:** In animal quarters, treat bedding, floor and floor coverings and any areas where fleas may hide. If left undisturbed, a deposit of this product will continue to kill fleas for several weeks. Repeat application when effectiveness diminishes but not more than one (1) time per week. Do not spray animals or humans, or apply to animal feed or watering equipment.

**DANGER:**
