The amendment to the label, submitted in connection with your registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Herbicide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the label and change listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
  - a. Deletion of the toxic inert ingredient, [redacted], from the formulation and substituting it with [redacted] is in compliance with PR Notice 87-6 and is acceptable.
  - b. In the revised label, the ingredient statement should be on the front panel.
  - c. Place the statement "Keep Out of Reach of Children" directly above the signal word "Warning."
  - d. The fire hazard caution should be placed under the "Physical and Chemical Hazards" subheading.
  - e. Delete the phrase "Contents Under Pressure" from below the signal word "Warning." It should be placed under the Physical and Chemical Hazards.
