

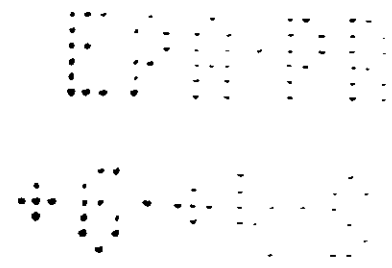

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS:

THIS PRODUCT CONTAINS AN EXTREMELY FLAMMABLE PROPELLANT. Do not use or store near fire, sparks or heated surfaces. Turn off pilot lights in gas appliances and unplug or turn off electrical equipment in the use area. After airing out phase is completed, reight pilot lights and reconnect electrical current. Do not smoke in the use area. Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Incineration of container may cause explosion.

This module is specially designed for use in closed areas where the control of odors is important. It will aid in the control of odors such as body odor, stale smoke, and cooking odors. It should be used in restrooms, dining rooms, serving areas, halls, lounges, offices, locker rooms, schools as well as most public or private areas where odor control is needed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

DIRECTIONS: Before placing, hand spray the air to prime. For best effect, hang dispenser about eye level and in a location where moving air will carry the particles throughout the desired area. One dispenser is recommended per 6000 cubic feet. Air movement and ventilation rate may vary this somewhat. Should you wish to actuate the Air Sanitizer manually, close the doors and windows, fill the room with mist and leave the room closed for 15 minutes.
