Submissions dated May 5, 1992 and May 26, 1992

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Submit one (1) copy of the finished labeling prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. Add the heading PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS directly above the phrase HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS. These heading should appear as follows:

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS  
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS  
CAUTION**

2. Add an appropriate STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT section to the product label text which provides information to the user concerning the toxicologically significant routes of exposure.

It is noted that you have not addressed the comments and requirements described in the Agency letters of December 8, 1989 and November 19, 1990. We will consider these points further during reregistration review of these active ingredients, this formulation, and its use patterns.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

**FOR USE IN AUTOMATIC DISPENSERS:** One dispensing unit should be installed for each 6,000 cubic feet of space to be treated. The dispenser activates the 54 mg. valve once every 15 minutes. After two hours of operation enough insecticide is suspended in the air to kill a substantial proportion of the flies, mosquitoes and gnats present. Usually the effectiveness will be noticeable within one hour after the dispenser is activated. If less than 24 hour control is required, the dispenser should be set to start one hour before control is desired and run one hour after control is no longer needed. Keep in mind that such factors as air flow rate, size of space treated, humidity and room temperatures all affect insect activity and control. Therefore, one unit per 6,000 cubic feet should be considered as an average need within adjustments made depending on specific conditions at place of usage. As with any method of insect control, best results are achieved when sanitation and other positive insect prevention practices are followed.

This 8 1/2 oz. can of insect killer contains approximately 3,400 "shots" sufficient to sustain operation for a total of 650 hours (35 days on around-the-clock basis) or 70 days on a 12-hour basis. When used on a 24-hour basis, it is suggested that the container be changed once a month (once every 2 months on a 12-hour basis).

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS and DOMESTIC ANIMALS:** The active ingredients of this product are toxic to humans and domestic animals. Automatic dispensers should not be installed near tanks. Users may want to remove fish from treatment rooms.

**PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS:** Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F. may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.

**CAUTION:** Do not use in nurseries or rooms where infants, ill or aged persons are confined. Do not use directly over or within 12 feet of any food handling dispensing area. Large drafts of forced ventilation may reduce or eliminate the insecticidal efficacy of this installation.
