Dear Ms. Watson :

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following conditions:

1. Add the word "Propoxur" in front of the chemical name in the active ingredient statement.
2. Delete the word "technical" listed *after* Piperonyl Butoxide in the ingredient statement.
3. Revise the First Aid Section as follows:
 - a. Add the statement "Contains an N-methyl carbamate that inhibits cholinesterase" to the Note to Physician.
 - b. Within the First Aid section, revise the second sentence of the *If Swallowed* statement, currently reading "Have a person sip a glass of water if able to do so", so that it reads "Do not give any liquid to the person." In addition, the Agency recommends the addition of an emergency phone number and the statement "Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment" to the First Aid section.
4. The *Direction for Use* should be placed after the Precautionary Statements.
5. Add the statement "Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal" so that it appears directly beneath the storage and disposal heading.

- 6. Add the following restrictions: "Do not apply this product in a way that will contact any person or pet, either directly or indirectly. Keep people and pets out of the area during application."

FOR OUTDOOR USE ONLY

Kills Wasps, Hornets and Yellow Jackets. This spray is fast acting when insects are hit directly. Allow about 24 hours for those insects which were not directly hit by spray to leave the area. If insects should return to the treated area, spray again. This container delivers a stream type spray, making it possible for the operator to stay back from the place sprayed. Good for use around food processing plants, restaurants, farms, utility poles and houses.

This formulation utilizes pyrethrins, piperonyl butoxide and a carbamate type insecticide, a combination particularly effective on this class of insect.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To Operate: Remove protective cap and depress button, being sure to aim spray opening at the location to be sprayed. Direct spray at insects wherever possible, and under eaves, into nests, cracks, holes or crevices where insects are noticed. Spray for about 10 seconds or until surface is moist from insecticide. To prevent entrance of insects into the house, spray around points where outside plumbing faucets enter the house and into any cracks and crevices in foundation as well as along sills and ledges. **IMPORTANT:** Do not use on plastic, styrofoam or auto paint.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:

CAUTION: May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove pets from area before spraying. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

FIRST AID STATEMENTS: IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **IF IN EYES:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **IF INHALED:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: ATROPINE SULFATE IS ANTIDOTAL. Contains petroleum distillates - vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Extremely flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from fire, sparks, and heated surfaces. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: **STORAGE:** Store

in a cool area away from heat or open flame. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do Not Puncture or Incinerate IF
