Subject: Formula revision; label revision
Misty Fog Away
EPA Registration Number 10807-63
Submission dated September 29, 1989

The amendment referred to above, removing the toxic inert ingredient methylene chloride, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the product label is enclosed for your records.

1. Delete the declaration "(allyl homolog of Cinerin 1)" from the ingredients statement.
2. Delete "Petroleum distillate" from the active ingredient statement and combine this percentage with that for the inert ingredients. Do not list "Petroleum distillate" separately.
3. Regarding the front panel of the product label, the precautionary heading should appear as follows:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

CAUTION

4. Under the HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS subsection, expand the statement to read as follows: "In the home, all food should be covered or removed prior to treatment. All food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered or removed during treatment or thoroughly washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse prior to use." Retain the statement "Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, storage or serving areas."

5. Under the STORAGE AND DISPOSAL subsection, the disposal declaration should read as follows:

DISPOSAL: Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper, and discard in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate container.


6. Submit the product specific product chemistry data for the product cited above. If this data was submitted earlier, provide the MRID number(s).
7. Since your data matrix does not provide a dielectrical breakdown voltage, the following statement must be added to the PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS heading:

Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

8. As described in the sumithrin standard, use the chemical name for d-cis/trans phenothrin on the product label. Delete "Related isomers" from the active ingredients statement and combine this percentage with the active so that it reads 0.2%. Do not list "Other isomers" separately.

It is understood that the use of the compound methylene chloride as a component in the product formulation is no longer consistent with the terms of registration of this pesticide.

Do not use fogger after spray has dried. Also treat dog quarters before allowing them to enter. **TO KILL FLEAS:** Follow directions for ticks and fleas in control of Coccidioides.
