### DIRECTIONS FOR USE General Classification

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

### STORAGE and DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.  
**DISPOSAL:** Do not re-use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collect on.

This product will kill Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Black Carpet Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Rice Weevils, Small Flying Moths, Spiders, Centipedes, Fleas, Ticks, Wasps, Pill Bugs, Crickets and Silverfish. Aids in control of Cockroaches.

**FOR FLYING AND CRAWLING INSECTS:** Cover exposed food, dishes and food handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

**TO OPERATE VALVE:** To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in center of room with valve for lock open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for four hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

**FOR TICKS:** Destroy pet's old bedding and replace. Treat dogs and cats with registered tick control product prior to re-entry.

**FOR FLEAS:** Follow same directions as for ticks, except use one can for each 1,500 cubic feet.

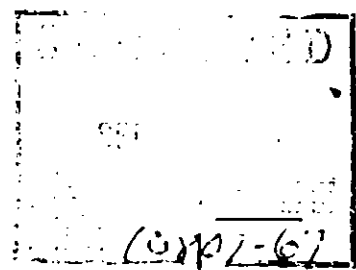
