**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**STORAGE & DISPOSAL:** STORAGE: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame. DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

This aerosol is designed for use in automatic activators set to dispense a 100 gram dose every 15 minutes. For use only in after hours on a 12 hour basis. Use one aerosol in an automatic activator for each 6,000 cubic feet of room space to be treated. Install the activator on a wall approximately 7 feet from the floor. Do not install directly over any food handling or dispensing area. The rate of air change, shape of space to be treated, humidity and temperature affect insect activity and insect control. One unit per 6,000 cubic feet should be considered an average ratio. Adjust the ratio depending upon the conditions under which the activator is used. Usually the effectiveness of this formula will be noticeable within one hour after the activator is started. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate thoroughly before re-entry. This 12 oz. aerosol contains enough material to operate 68 days on a 12 hour basis. It is suggested the aerosol be changed once every two months on a 12 hour basis. As with any method of insect control, improved performance is achieved when good sanitary practices and other supplementary household control methods are used.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:**

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:**

**CAUTION:** Do not use in nurseries or rooms where infants, ill or aged persons are confined. Do not install directly over or within 12 feet of any food handling or dispensing area. Metering device must be timed not to dispense while food processing is underway. Foods must be removed or covered during treatment.
