The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above under The Federal Insecticide, Fungicide And Rodenticide Act, as amended bringing the product label into compliance with PR Notices 2001-1 and 2001-6 is acceptable subject to the comment listed below. A stamped copy of the amended label is enclosed for your records.

Since this product contains petroleum distillates, change the First Aid Statement for If Swallowed to read:


IF SWALLOWED:

- * Immediately call a poison control center or doctor.
- * Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor.
- * Do not give any liquid to the person.
- * Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Submit two copies of the finished label before the product is released for shipment under this revised label.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: **STORAGE:** Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do Not Puncture or Incinerate IF EMPTY: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. IF PARTLY FILLED: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.

This aerosol is designed for use in automatic activators set to dispense a 100 gram dose every 15 minutes. For use only in after hours on a 12 hour basis. Use one aerosol in an automatic activator for each 6,000 cubic feet of room space to be treated. Install the activator on a wall approximately 7 feet from the floor. Do not install directly over any food handling or dispensing area. The rate of air change, shape of space to be treated, humidity and temperature affect insect activity and insect control. One unit per 6,000 cubic feet should be considered an average ratio. Adjust the ratio depending upon the conditions under which the activator is used. Usually the effectiveness of this formula will be noticeable within one hour after the activator is started. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate thoroughly before re-entry. This 12 oz. aerosol contains enough material to operate 68 days on a 12 hour basis. It is suggested the aerosol be changed once every two months on a 12 hour basis. As with any method of insect control, improved performance is achieved when good sanitary practices and other supplementary household control methods are used.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:

CAUTION: Do not use in nurseries or rooms where infants, ill or aged persons are confined. Do not install directly over or within 12 feet of any food handling or dispensing area. Metering device must be timed not to dispense while food processing is underway. Foods must be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces must be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse before using. Do not install

within 3 feet of air ducts. Do not use in public areas while customers or workers are present. Timers must be set to dispense only during non-business hours. Carefully follow directions for the dispenser unit when installing the dispenser and replacing cans or conducting maintenance. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

FIRST AID STATEMENTS: IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **IF IN EYES:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Contains petroleum distillates - vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.
