STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.
Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

DIRECTIONS

Shake can well before using. To Operate: turn dispenser upside down, point valve opening toward area being treated. Press valve to release spray. This product is a liquid, non-selective, persistent general herbicide designed for use where control of all vegetation is desired. Apply in late spring after the most predominant weeds have emerged. Apply in such a spray pattern to wet out the weed completely and the amount to use is dependent on the surface area of the weed to be controlled. The frequency of the application required depends on the soil type, rainfall and other natural conditions. Repeat as necessary.
