#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**PROHIBITIONS:** Do not contaminate water, food, or feed, by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to label instructions.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Triple Rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in sanitary landfill.

**GENERAL:** Use this product as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, waterbugs, silverfish, ticks, fleas, and other insects in localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed.

#### For Spot Treatment, Apply as Follows:

**TO KILL COCKROACHES, ANTS, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS and SOWBUGS:** Spray area where these pests are found or may hide, including crevices in walls, along baseboards and door and window frames, behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets and other installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, apply to ant trails and around doors, windows and anywhere they enter. **TO KILL BROWN DOG TICKS and FLEAS:** Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby window and door frames and localized area of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and replaced. **DO NOT SPRAY PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT.**

#### For Crack and Crevice, Apply as Follows:

**To Kill ANTS, ROACHES, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, SOWBUGS, SPIDERS, EARWIGS, BROWN DOG TICKS, FLEAS, CARPET BEETLES and DERMESIDAE:** Apply to cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of delivering a pin stream should be used between different elements of construction, behind voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where the above listed insects hide.

Do not apply directly to food. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food. **APPLICATIONS OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS OTHER THAN AS A CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ARE PROHIBITED.**

**TO KILL FLIES AND MOSQUITOES:** Use only out of doors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window frames, porches, patios and garages. Pests may enter the home. Also, spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under the eaves) or porches, patios and garages. Mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat when necessary.
