### GENERAL PURPOSE FLYING INSECT KILLER

#### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Wear a pesticide respirator (not approved for use in food processing areas) under the provisions of 30 CFR Part 11. Contains petroleum distillates. If swallowed, contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention. If sprayed on food, cover or remove all food processing surfaces. Thoroughly wash all food processing equipment. Inspected meat and poultry plants must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water spray. Do not apply directly to animals. Wash teats of dairy animals before milking.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT EYE CONTACT:** Flush with water. If persistent irritation occurs, get medical attention. **INHALATION:** Remove victim to fresh air. **DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **GENERAL:** This concentrate is designed for use and used in mechanical sprayers such as the IFCO Model 111 or Micromist, which meet Food Additive Regulation 171.1152 and applied in fogging equipment such as the Microfog or Microfogger. Dilute with the oil specified above and apply as a contact spray to kill crawling insects shown later on this label. **NOTE:** When used in hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment. Ventilate for two hours after treatment.

**For Use in Homes, Restaurants, Food Processing Plants and Other Buildings:**  
**Space Spray - Undiluted - To Kill Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Gnats and Small Flying Moths:** Close room and shut door. Apply at the rate of 4 ounces per 1,000 cubic feet of space. Direct output from aerosol generator upward toward ceiling. Thoroughly before re-entry. Repeat as necessary. **Space Spray - Diluted for Ordinary Mechanical Fogging Equipment:** Cover or remove exposed food and food handling surfaces. Close room and shut off all air conditioning or ventilating equipment. Apply at the rate of 50 ft. oz. of dilute spray (4 gal.) per 25,000 cubic feet of space. Direct output from aerosol generator upward toward ceiling. Do not re-enter treated areas. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. **Contact Spray - Dilute Concentrate plus 2 parts of oil and mix well.** Spray outside walls of grain bins, flooring, about base of milling machinery, and other insect harborage areas. Apply at the rate of 1 quart of spray per 1,000 square feet of surface. Force spray into all cracks and crevices. **For Use in Dairy and Beef Bins, Swine Housing, Poultry Houses:** **Space Spray - Undiluted for use in Aerosol Generators - To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths:** Close room and close house as tightly as possible. Apply as a fine mist over the livestock in stanchions or holding pens. Spray is directed and applied above the animals and direct spray to center of the area where animals are housed. Repeat daily, morning and afternoon, or as required. Keep sprayer unit, reservoir, and nozzle clean to ensure proper operation.

**Mechanical Fogging Equipment - To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Gnats:** Prepare for application. Dilute concentrate plus 2 parts of refined kerosene and mix well. Apply at the rate of 50 ft. oz. of dilute spray (4 gal.) per 25,000 cubic feet of room and closing. Leave room closed for 2 hours then ventilate area.
