Dear Ms. Holland:

This is in response to your labeling and your Confidential Statement of Formula dated March 7, 1994, re-submitted in response to the EPA letter dated February 24, 1994. The purpose of the amendment (originally submitted on May 20, 1992) was a label revision in response to an EPA letter dated May 5, 1992 concerning ingredients determined to be pesticidally inert.

The labeling and Confidential Statement of Formula referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, are acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

- 1. Either delete the Environmental Hazards section of the label, or replace the three sentences under the Environmental Hazards section with:

Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.
