
Dear Ms. Holland:

This is in response to your labeling and your Confidential Statement of Formula dated March 7, 1994, re-submitted in response to the EPA letter dated February 24, 1994. The purpose of the amendment (originally submitted on May 20, 1992) was a label revision in response to an EPA letter dated May 5, 1992 concerning ingredients determined to be pesticidally inert.

The labeling and Confidential Statement of Formula referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, are acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

Either delete the Environmental Hazards section of the label, or replace the three sentences under the Environmental Hazards section with:

Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For quidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

Preclean all surfaces with an appropriate detergent. Rinse and wipe dry.

DISINFECTING AND DEODORIZING: For general disinfecting and deodorizing of hard inanimate surfaces, mix a solution of 4 ounces of product concentrate per gallon of water. Apply to surface with a mop, sponge, cloth or sprayer. Allow surface to remain wet for 10 minutes. Rinse with potable water.

LIMITED DISINFECTING: For bathrooms, showers, bathtubs, toilet bowls, locker rooms, porcelain and ceramic tile and other similar surfaces, use 4 ounces of product concentrate per gallon of water. Apply to surface with sprayer, mop, cloth or sponge. Agitate and allow to remain on surface for 10 minutes. Pick up excess solution and allow to air dry or rinse with water and dry. FLOORS, WALLS AND WOODWORK: Solution may be used to disinfect surfaces that are not harmed by water based products. Mix solution of 4 ounces of product concentrate with 3 gallons of water. Apply solution with mop, cloth, sponge or sprayer. Allow surface to remain wet for 10 minutes. Mop up excess or rinse and allow to dry.

BARBER SHOP AND BEAUTY SALON EQUIPMENT: Preclean implements, then soak combs, brushes, razors, scissors and other related articles in a solution containing 4 ounces of product concentrate per gallon of water. Allow to soak for 10 minutes. Rinse and dry.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:~

STORAGE: Do not expose product to heat, sparks or open flame. Store container in a cool, dry location. Do not expose product to temperature extremes. Store product in original shipping container in a locked storage area. Keep container closed when not in use.
