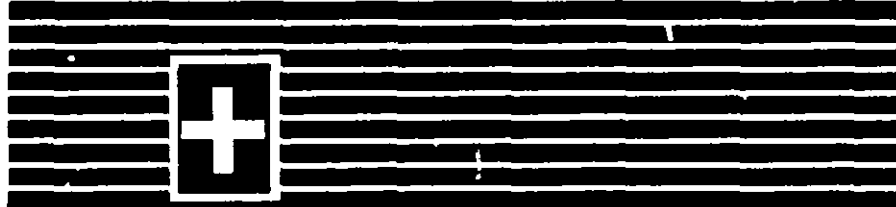

GENERAL INFORMATION: This product produces a clear, sparkling yellow solution that brings the disinfecting duties when mixed with water. Use this product concentrate in sick rooms, nurseries, restaurants and hotels. This product is not to be used as a terminal sterilant/high level disinfectant on any surface or instrument that either enter into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body, or (2) contacts intact mucous membranes, or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body. This product may be used to disinfect critical medical devices prior to sterilization or high level disinfection.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:
CAUTION: Cause eye and skin irritation. Avoid contact of product with eyes or skin. Avoid contamination of all surfaces, equipment and utensils must be removed, covered or thoroughly rinsed prior to re-use.
ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish. Treated effluent should not be discharged into surface water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. This product should be used at regular intervals on floors, lavatories, urinals, walls, telephones, furniture, garbage pails, refrigerators, diaper pails, lockers and lockers. To preserve the good deodorizing properties of this product, do not mix with other deodorizing agents.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the following directions:
General Disinfecting: Mix 3 ounces of product to each gallon of water for general disinfecting of: Showers, Animal Quarters, Nurseries, Kitchens, Locker Rooms, Laundries and other areas in need of sanitizing and deodorizing.
Deodorizing: Add 1 to 2 ounces of product per gallon of mop water. This will provide excellent deodorizing action.
Hospitals and Sick Rooms: Use 5 ounces per gallon of water for thorough disinfection. Allow surface to dry.
For Carpets: Spray a 1:15 solution on carpets as a good deodorant and anti-static agent. This helps to control odors at this dilution. It is not intended as a terminal disinfectant for carpeting.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: **STORAGE:** Do not expose product to temperature extremes. Store in a locked storage area. Keep container closed when not in use. Do not contaminate water, food or feed. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility with a dry absorbent and dispose of in accordance with state or local regulations. Wear protective clothing.
DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in accordance with state and local authorities.
